



Leadership Team Meeting Minutes
City of Thornton September 30, 2009

A special combined Leadership Team and TAC meeting was held to take advantage of the Coordinators trip to Denver for a training class with Gold Systems on the 29th. The coordinators presented a power point presentation that summarizes the training class regarding the conversion of the DSN to the WQX format. The presentation is posted on the website at www.coloradowaterquality.org. The coordinators were able to attend the class at no cost as the tribes who had paid for the training gave permission for the coordinators to attend for free. Vic agreed to send a thank you letter to the tribes thanking them from their generosity.

The data that has been uploaded to the old DSN system has been converted by GS to the new system. It is important that all data contributors review their data to ensure it was converted over correctly. You can view your data at <http://cdsn.awqms.com>. The old data portal is no longer available. The coordinators stated that our new system is basically in a beta testing mode so it will be important to review data and report any problems or report any solutions you find to resolving the problems.

Currently the AQWMS (new DSN) system will not allow others to view data other than their own. The intent is that the public could search for data through the map. Karl stated that the AQWMS site could be configured to allow for access to the data by the public unless the contributing organization has secured it.

One additional note of importance is that the detection limits are handled differently in the new system. The coordinators will be developing some training material for the users. In addition there will be live demos presented at various venues in the future such as the Water Quality Forum and South Platte CURE (December meeting). You will receive information from the Coordinators about these opportunities.
