



Leadership Team Meeting Minutes
December 17, 2010

MAP

Lynn reported that she has had discussions with Andy at Gold Systems regarding the to do list. They have been busy uploading USGS data. The first extent will be Colorado view and the second will be the basins. Karl needs to get the shape file to GS. With the shape file Lynn should be able to make the map faster. Only two base layers are working now but maybe the others are just working slowly. Lynn will have GS look into this. When the cursor is placed over the blue water drops (CDSN sites), the user can see the organization and media type. GS said media type may slow the system down but Lynn did not experience this. Lynn would like to see the maps fill the monitor screen; she feels this is included in the original scope. There are four data sets in the data base; USGS, Colorado WQX STORET, NACWA, and NWIS. Lynn feels the map is 60 to 70% complete. You can view the map demo at www.maps.goldsystems.com. The deliverable for the map is December 31, 2010. Gold Systems has asked for a one month extension. Lynn will check with Lucia about this.

The coordinators are working on a separate website to house the map. This will reduce clutter on the AWQMS site. The new website will be at coloradodata.org; it is currently a beta testing site.

BUDGET

Lynn will provide a provide a budget summary for the next meeting. There has been no activity since last meeting.

GRANT EXTENSION

Barb commented that the grant extension, based on discussions with Lucia, is going through. Hopefully a contract will be in place by January 1st. Sarah Reeves has provided Lucia with the insurance and other requested information.

NEW GRANT APPLICATION

The application for a new 319 grant was submitted December 2, 2010. The eligible applications will be reviewed on January 20th and the Division will present the selected projects to the Water Quality Control Commission in March. The federal budget has not been approved so the amount of money available for 319 projects is an unknown. The Non-Point Source Alliance would like a demo and some training on the DSN and map. Karl will ask Amy Konowal (replaced Dan Beley) if there is any follow-up funding that can be applied to the map project.

SWAP

The Left Hand Watershed SWAP is set for March 2, 2011. Invitations will go out soon.

Barb has a scheduled call with the Piceance Watershed group next week to discuss their SWAP.

TRAINING

The Webinars have been filling up fast. The attendance has been limited to 14 including the presenters to allow all questions to be answered. Two more webinars will be set up in January. The group believes in-person training needs to be provided in addition to the webinars. Specific data uploading and downloading training probably needs to be hands-on. Barb asked the coordinators to develop a 2011 training schedule that meets the grant scope.

NATIONAL COMMITTEE

Work is starting on the planning of the 2012 Portland Conference.

Vic will send out the work plan Barb developed to the TAC list that will be provided by Barb or Jeff.

ROUND TABLE

Vic will contact Northern to inquire about their previous 2010 contribution pledge of \$2,500.
